CACH Community Referral Program - Referral Types

- **Community Referrals:** These referrals come through our online Community Referral Survey.
- **Agency Referrals:** These referrals come from local agencies looking for assistance for their client(s).
- **Self Referrals:** These referrals come directly from an individual or household who needs assistance. These typically come through our Facebook page or website.
- **Outreach Team Engagement:** These are individuals our internal team notices or makes direct contact with without a referral.

Engagement Updates

- As of August, we started conducting street outreach in Chester County.
- We are in contact with the Clover Area Assistance Center (CAAC) to serve individuals residing in the Clover/York area.
- We are starting monthly visitations to Moss Justice to speak with inmates and educate them on how to navigate the homeless response system.
- We are working to finalize a Pocket Guide for Lancaster and Chester Counties. This will be made available on our website.




