OUTREACH UPDATES

CACH Community Referral Program - Referral Types

- Community Referrals: These referrals come through our online Community Referral Survey.
- Agency Referrals: These referrals come from local agencies looking for assistance for their client(s).
- Self Referrals: These referrals come directly from an individual or household who needs assistance. These typically come through our Facebook page or website.
- Outreach Team Engagement: These are individuals our internal team notices or makes direct contact with without a referral.





CACH Community Referral Program

- Sixteen referrals were made in the month of August.
- The Street Outreach Team followed up on both referrals.

Engagement Updates

- 41 Total clients served (unduplicated)
- 28 New client connections
- 6 Clients engaged in case management
- 5 Clients added to Prioritization List
- 2 Clients connected to employment
- 2 Clients connected to health services



OUTREACH UPDATES

Engagement Updates

- As of August, we started conducting street outreach in Chester County.
- We are in contact with the Clover Area Assistance Center (CAAC) to serve individuals residing in the Clover/York area.
- We are staring monthly visitations to Moss Justice to speak with inmates and educate them on how to navigate the homeless response system.
- We are working to finalize a Pocket Guide for Lancaster and Chester Counties.
 This will be made available on our website.

Coordinated Entry System (CES) Updates


- MACH is entering the testing phase for a new CES assessment tool and has selected a few pilot agencies to test the tool.

Veteran Recovery Housing Program

- Veteran status must be verified by SCARR and DOADAS.
- Each veteran is entitle to \$1,250 a month for housing-related expenses, for up to six months or until funding is exhausted.
- Aplications can be submitted via the DAODAS website.
