

FAQs: 2025 CACH Coalition Fundraiser

1. Is this a physical event? No, this is not an in-person event. The 2025 CACH Coalition Fundraiser is a week-long online campaign (April 21–25) designed to raise awareness and support for our local homeless response system. Throughout the week, we will share educational videos, stories, and impact updates via our website and social media to highlight our efforts to make homelessness rare, brief, and non-recurring.

2. How does the fundraiser work? Individuals and businesses can support the campaign by making a donation or sponsorship pledge. Your support helps sustain and expand services and programs designed to prevent and reduce homelessness. Throughout the week, we will share information on how we are working to address homelessness in our region, garner support, and focus on long-term solutions.
